

Cul-de-sac Coordinator Meeting – Notes
7:30 pm, Tuesday, 5/26/2009
Kehr's Mill Elementary Library

Two trustees attended:

Thirteen coordinators attended:

These coordinators represented the following cul-de-sacs:
Country Field Ct, Courtleigh Ln (south), Long Gate Ct, Mint Hill, Shadyford Ct, Silverwood Ct, Silverwood Ln, Thistlebriar, Vineyard

Each coordinator introduced themselves and mentioned any pertinent issues:
B. Loebig – two water main breaks at the Silverwood Ct circle resulted in the loss of most vegetation.
Masons – Mint Hill has a dead tree that needs to be removed; it is felt the circle does not need a replacement tree.
Hinders – Country Field Ct has a thorn tree. While the thorns can be a problem, the tree is hardy and of the right scale so it doesn't block the street light.
J. Nozka – an evergreen tree blocks the view through the circle. It should be replaced with shrubs/bushes.

The map of the subdivision should be available on the web site so the coordinators can find all cul-de-sacs. Don will work this issue and notify all when it's available.

MF-CE coordinators should nominate lawn/garden homes for the Chesterfield program. Any winners would be a feather for the subdivision. Will put information on the website, and send an email about the program to our list.

Coordinators will visit all cul-de-sacs and rate them, providing the 4 worst, and the 4 best cul-de-sacs in the subdivision. All coordinators present were given their ballots. This information will be used to determine which circles will be updated if/when funds are available. The ballots will be returned no later than 6/30/2009.

During roundtable, the following suggestions were made:

- Participate in Chesterfield Arbor Day (spring) and get free trees and shrubs.
- Check for end of season special pricing at area nurseries
- The Missouri Conservation department program has special pricing and availability once a year. Mike will notify us when this program is active.
- Remove any grass on circles, replacing it with mulch. This would conserve water, lower mowing and provide a consistent presentation.

The next meeting will be scheduled after all ballot information has been returned and tabulated.
